Strike Action a Success in Hackney

Thousands of Hackney workers take action in defence of pensions. Libraries schools and depots shut in biggest day of action for decades.

As the sun rose over the Town Hall on a cold November morning Hackney Unison members were already on the pickets standing defiantly in defence of public sector pensions.

The strike in Hackney was well attended and although we have not yet compiled all the figures we had great turnout on the day.

The vast majority of schools, all but one library and depots such as Florfield Road were all shut on the day. Estate Cleaners and

Grounds Maintenance staff, Gardeners and Rangers also took action in large numbers.

The Hackney Homes call centre was taking emergency calls only.

Mental Health services were significantly reduced

and scores of other sections such as the DAAT saw high numbers of staff on strike.

Hackney also featured heavily in the media being covered in the Telegraph and Guardian as well as on local and international radio. Hundreds attended the rally outside the Town Hall at 10.30 before marching to Homerton Hospital to join members from various unions on the pickets there.

Although it was a good solid day of action this is just the beginning of a struggle for decent pensions which is likely to last for some time.

Members may need to take further action in the future if we are to beat this disgraceful government and its plans to smash the public sector.

Going on Strike is hard and Hackney Unison understands the pressure it puts on our members however we must continue to stand strong because if we allow this government to hoodwink us into giving up our pensions we will never ever get them back again!
